

## WAIKATO RACING CLUB TRIALS | Tuesday 9 June

The Waikato Racing Club are thrilled to be hosting the first set of trials for the upper North Island. It marks a significant step towards the return to racing.

In preparation for Tuesday trials we ask that stakeholders please familiarize themselves with the following information to ensure a smooth running of what is set to be a very busy day.

### EARLIER START TIME;

Due to the huge number of entries we will **commence the trials at 10am**. This will be a one off. We thank NZTR, Northern Starting Crew, Jockey's Association and RIU for their positive support in these unique circumstances.

### CONTRACT TRACING;

Every individual entering the Waikato Racing Club footprint will be encouraged to sign in via **"Racing Tracing"** This online contract tracing application has been developed by the WRC with key industry sponsor Website Angels, in consultation with NZTR.

Following the use at tomorrow's trials it is intended the application will be rolled out nationwide.

Please head to **rtnz.nz** and familiarise yourself with the site. The site code for tomorrow's trials is **RAPA**.

The application allows one person in a truck or vehicle to check in all the attendees. This should assist with the process being completed in a timely manner.

### ENTRANCE TO THE TRACK;

Please allow additional time for your entry to the course due to the contract tracing measures as mentioned above.

To ensure contract tracing is adhered to, there will only be **ONE entry** to the course. This is the **entry off Ken Browne Drive**. Turn left off Te Rapa Rd into Garnett Ave, passing Spotlight and turn right at the roundabout.

**Sir Tristram Avenue will be closed to all vehicles.**
